

Planes, Trains, Automobiles, and Shuttles Your Bootcamp Transportation Options

We can't wait to welcome you to sunny South Florida. Once your plane lands, the real adventure begins! We want to make sure you're aware of all the transportation options, so you can plan your next moves once your feet touch the ground.

Airport

The host hotel (Delray Beach Marriott) is located near 3 major airports: 20 miles south of Palm Beach (PBI); 35 miles north of Ft. Lauderdale (FLL) and 50 miles north of Miami (MIA).

Booking Flights

Airlines vary largely depending on where you are flying out of. So, we recommend checking online travel websites such as www.hipmunk.com for the best airfare deals.

<u>Uber</u> and <u>LYFT</u>:

You can download these mobile apps to your phone and catch a ride from the airport; both are typically less expensive than a yellow cab. And, both options have a "pool" type selection where you can share a ride to make it even more affordable. I also encourage you to go to the Bootcamp Facebook group and find someone landing at a similar time to share a ride.

Tri-Rail

You also have a very clean/affordable metro option called the Tri-Rail, which costs less than \$10. At the West Palm Beach and Fort Lauderdale airports, you can get to Tri-Rail via a free shuttle transport. (If you fly into Miami, the Tri-Rail stops at the airport itself.)

Once you reach the Delray stop, you can take <u>the free Delray</u> Roundabout Shuttle to your hotel. Be sure to plan to wait for the shuttles and the train.

This is a good option if you have light luggage.
